### **Kiley leads Kingston charge at provincial convention #GPO2018**

(Kingston ON) The leadership of Kingston and The Islands Green Party of Ontario candidate was on full display this weekend as party members from across the province met for a pre-election convention in Guelph.

Robert Kiley, who ran for MPP in 2011 and doubled his vote in 2014, spoke to over 250 Greens at the Gala Dinner, where he profiled Kingston and The Islands and spoke to his reasons for running.

"I'm running to show that politicians can be honest. To show that policy can help people, small businesses and the planet. And that these things can be done together," said Kiley.

Kiley also spearheaded the development of a number of policies that were passed by the provincial membership. He attended the convention with 9 others from the Kingston and The Islands Green Party, including 5 members of his core campaign team.

"These policies promote social, economic, environmental and democratic justice. The best part is, they are Green values," Kiley told the audience, including newly elected Green Party PEI MLA, Hannah Bell and GPO leader Mike Schreiner.

Mr. Kiley and the Kingston and The Islands Greens will be launching their campaign platform in early spring, in advance of the June 7 election. Details to be announced in days to come.
